Family Unit & Dynamics

- · What do your parents or guardians do for work?
- · How many siblings do you have?
- · What is your birth order?
- Who do you consider your immediate family?
- Who did you grow up living with?
- Who makes decisions in your family?

Education

- How was school structured in your countries?
- What was your primary and secondary school experience like?
- What are you planning to study here at OSU?
- What are important life lessons you've learned?

Hobbies & Interests

- What do you do for entertainment?
- What are your hobbies and interests?
- What is your favorite food from your home country and culture?
- Who are your favorite artists (music, film, etc.)?
- Who are popular artists from your country?
- What is your favorite films and TV Shows?
- What are your favorite books and why are they are favorites?
- · What kind of art inspires you?



Gift Giving & Celebrations

- What major events/holidays do you celebrate in your culture?
- How do you show appreciation to someone?
