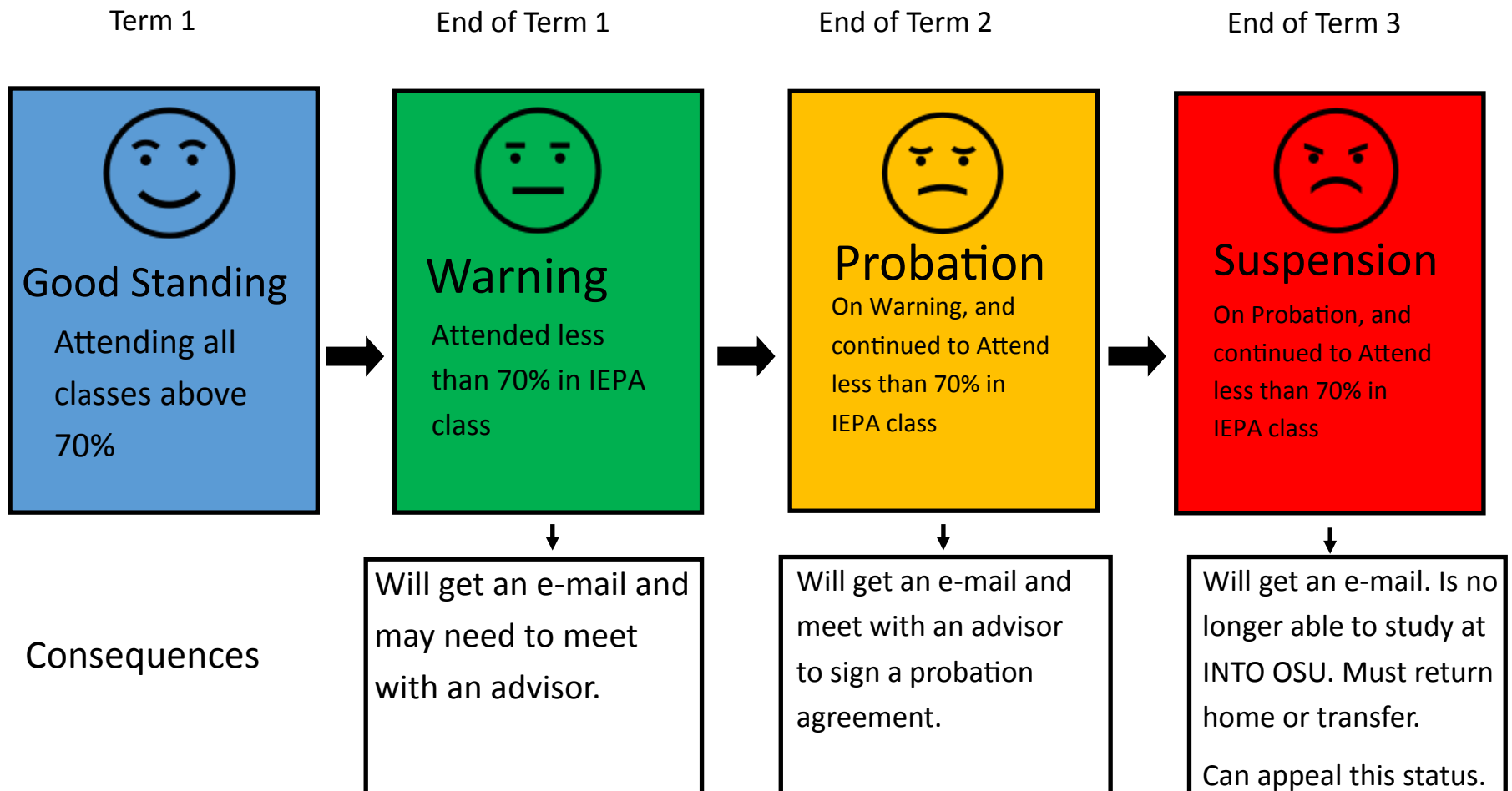


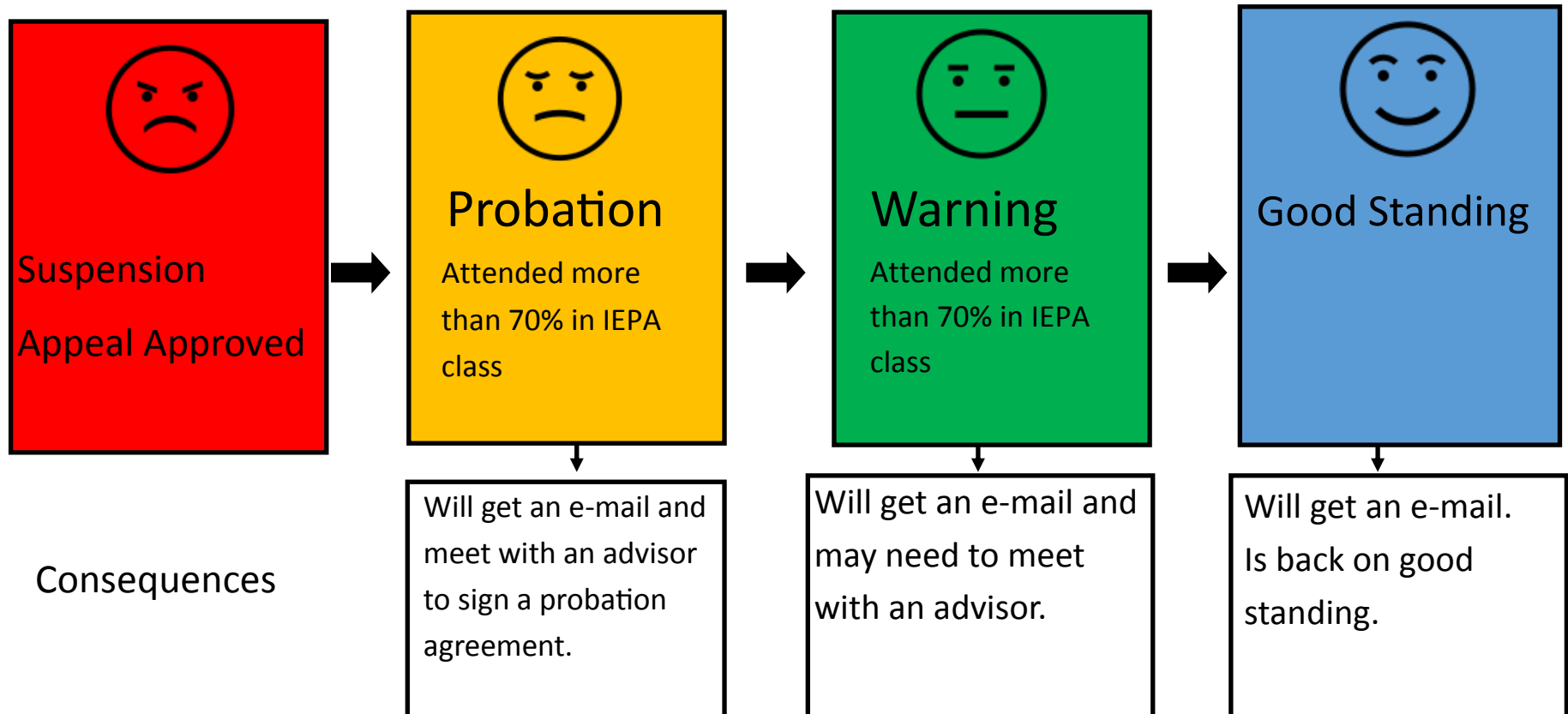
INTO OSU Attendance Status-Not Attending

Students must attend 70% or higher in every IEPA class to stay on good standing. If a student attends less than 70% in any class (including enrichment or elective courses), the student will be put on the next attendance standing for the beginning of the next term.



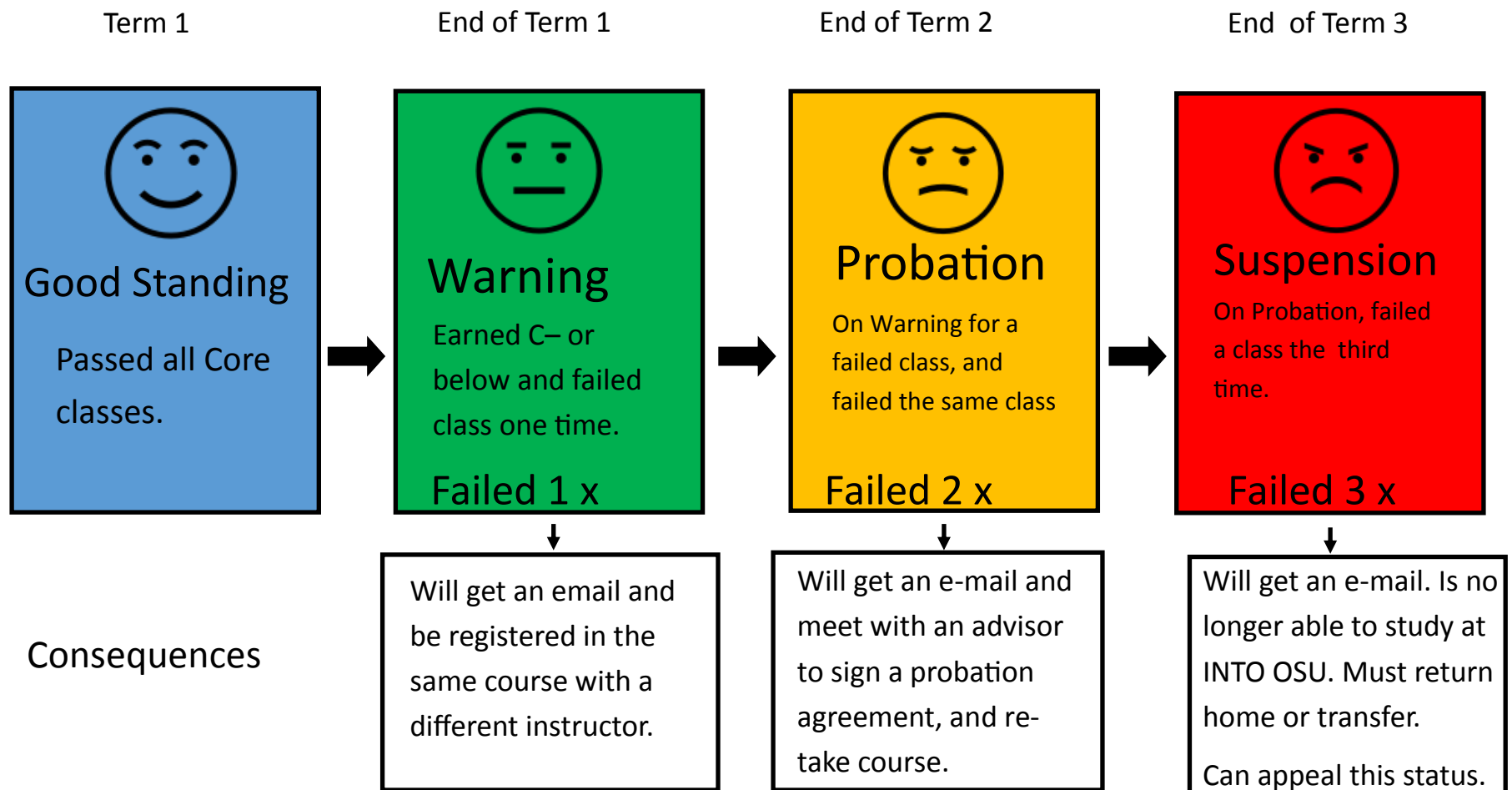
INTO OSU Attendance Status-Improving Status

Students must attend 70% or higher in every IEPA class to stay on good standing. If a student attends more than 70% in any class (including enrichment or elective courses), the student will improve their attendance standing back to the prior level.



INTO OSU Academic Progress-Failing IEPA

Students must earn a C (73%) in their IEPA Reading/Writing/Grammar classes, or IEPA Listening/Speaking classes. This also includes IEPA 056 and 066 Extensions classes to stay in Good standing. If they fail one of their classes, they go to Warning. They must retake this class with a different instructor. If they continue to fail the same class a second time, they will be on Probation. If they fail it a third time, they will be suspended. This does not apply to enrichment or elective courses.



INTO OSU Academic Progress-Passing course

If students pass the course (73% or higher) that they failed, they will be back on Good standing for their new academic course. Their academic progress standing does not carry with them into the new core class.
